- To understand and learn how to work with addiction

- To understand addiction as a family illness
- To be able to work with conflict and powerful emotions in the family
- To consider the requirements of the assessment process when working with addiction
- To explore a range of addictive processes – alcohol, drugs, food, gambling, sex
- To have an understanding of a range of different theories useful for working with both families and addiction
- To explore the impact of trauma caused by addiction on the family
- To understand how addiction is often underpinned by trauma and the most effective models of working with trauma and addiction
- To understand what recovery from addiction looks like
